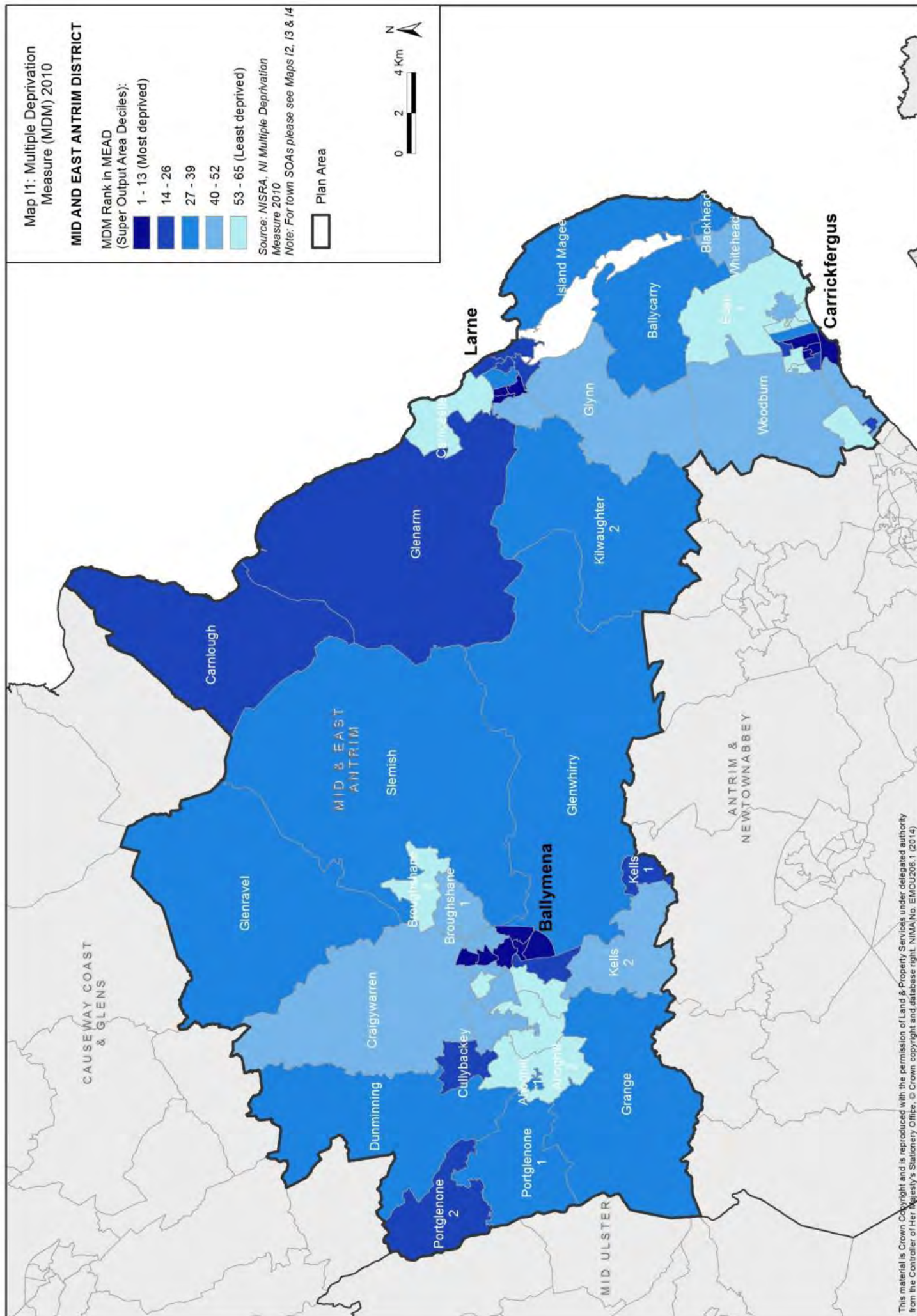

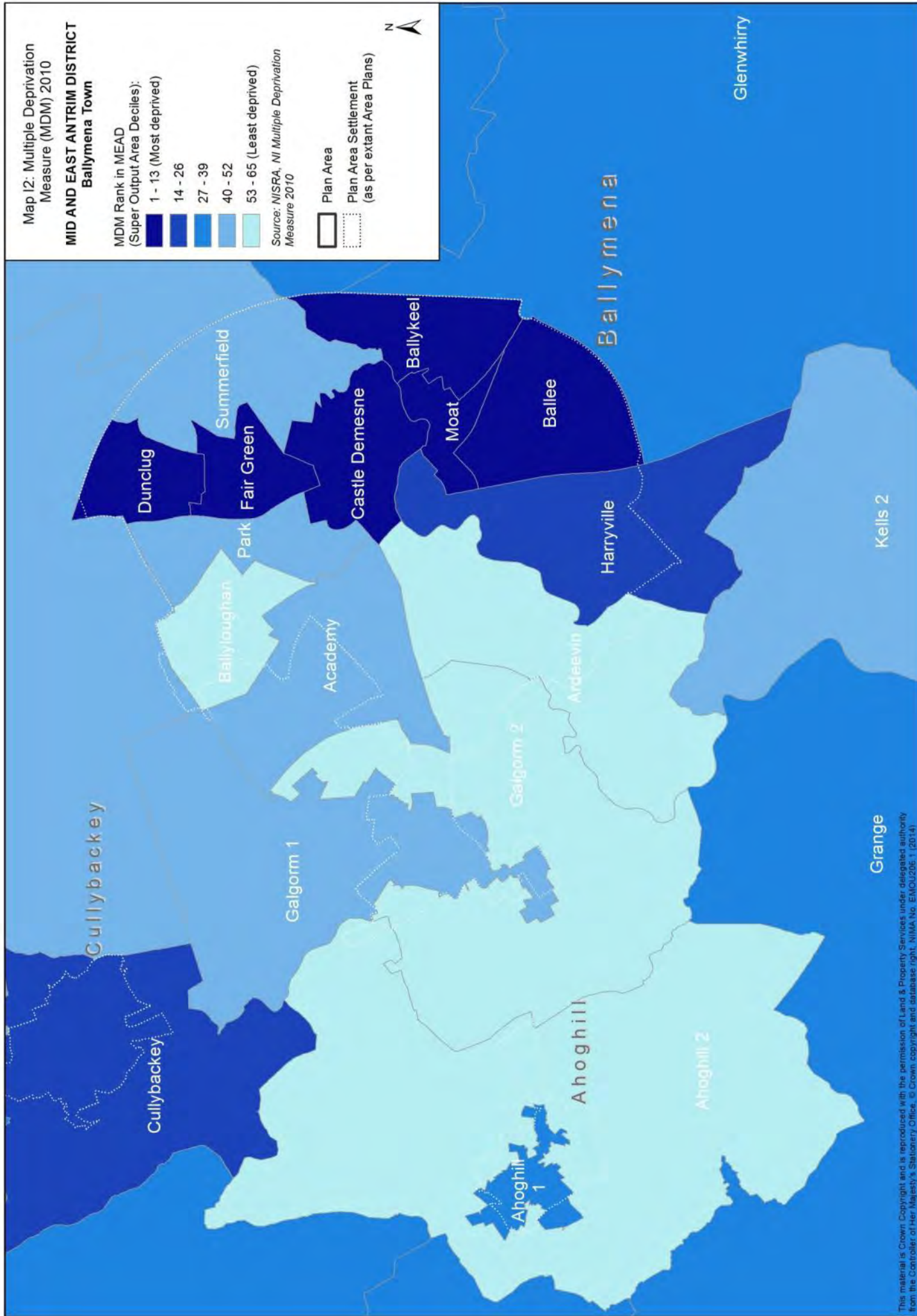

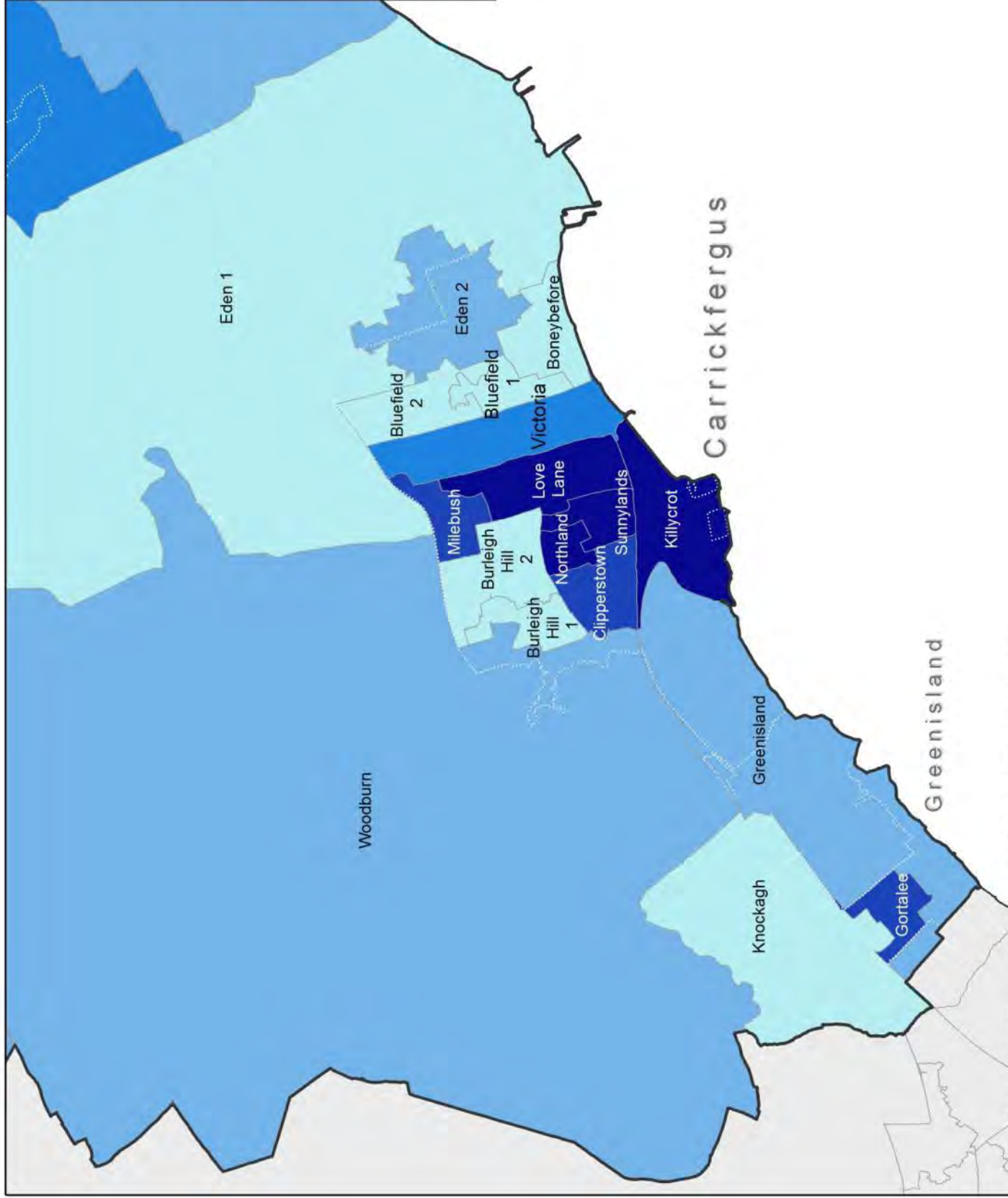
Map 13: Multiple Deprivation Measure (MDM) 2010

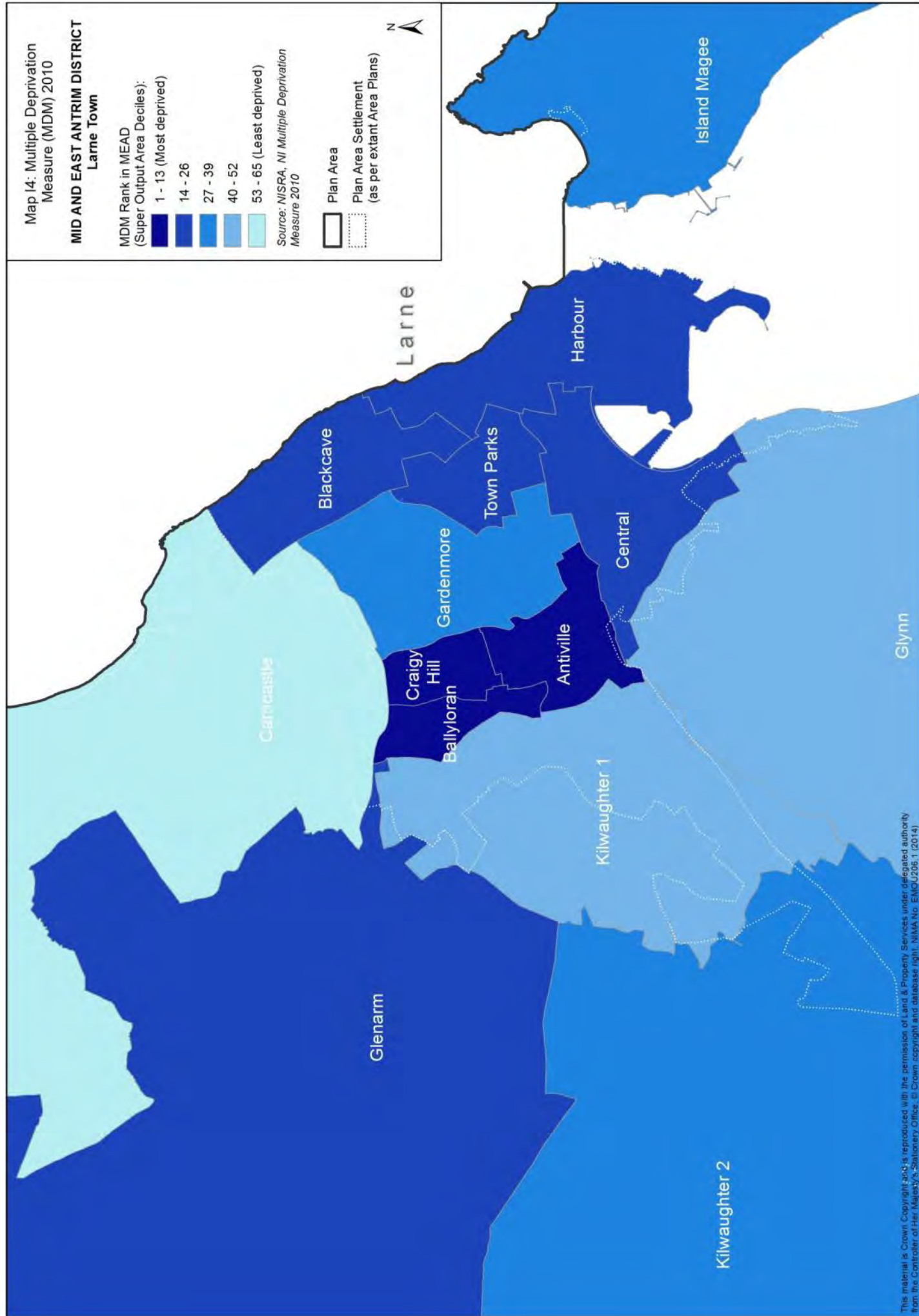

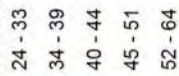

MID AND EAST ANTRIM DISTRICT

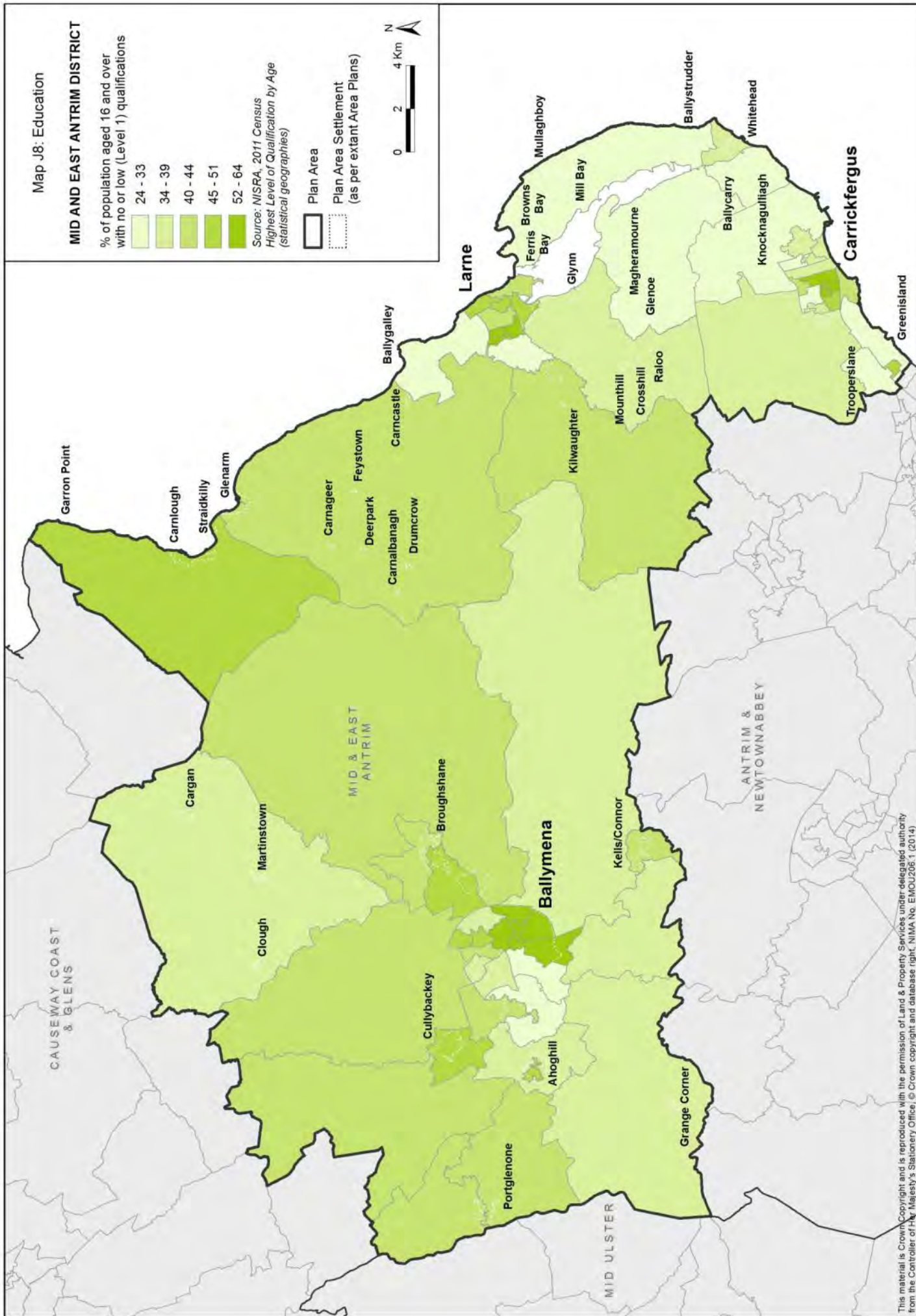
