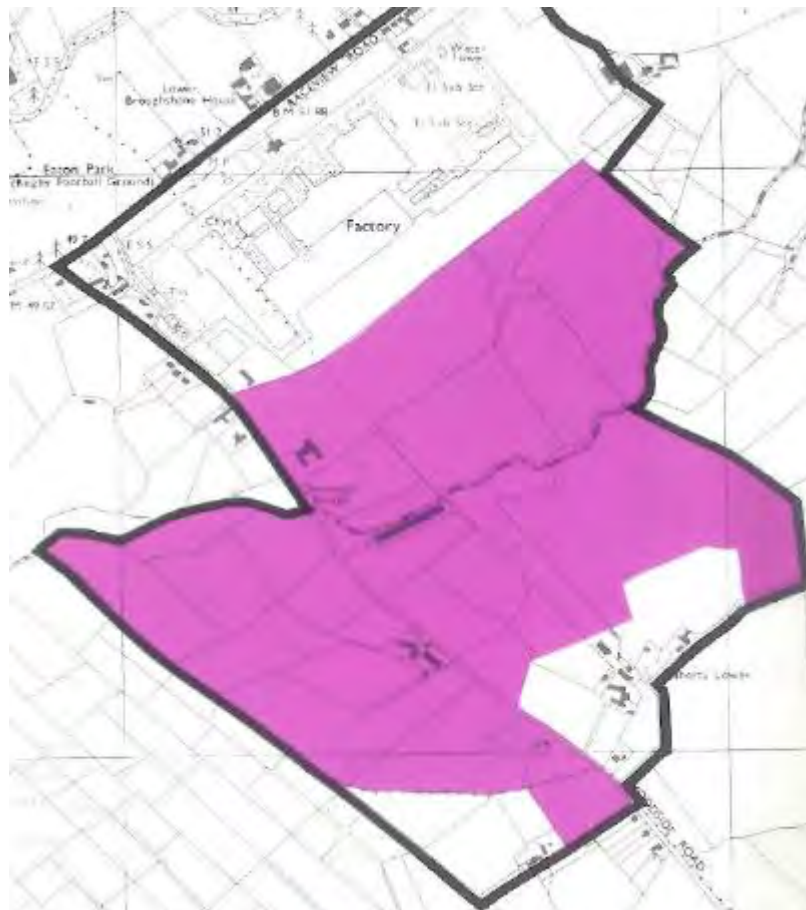


Fig. A2: Ballymena Area Plan 1986-2001 – Galgorm

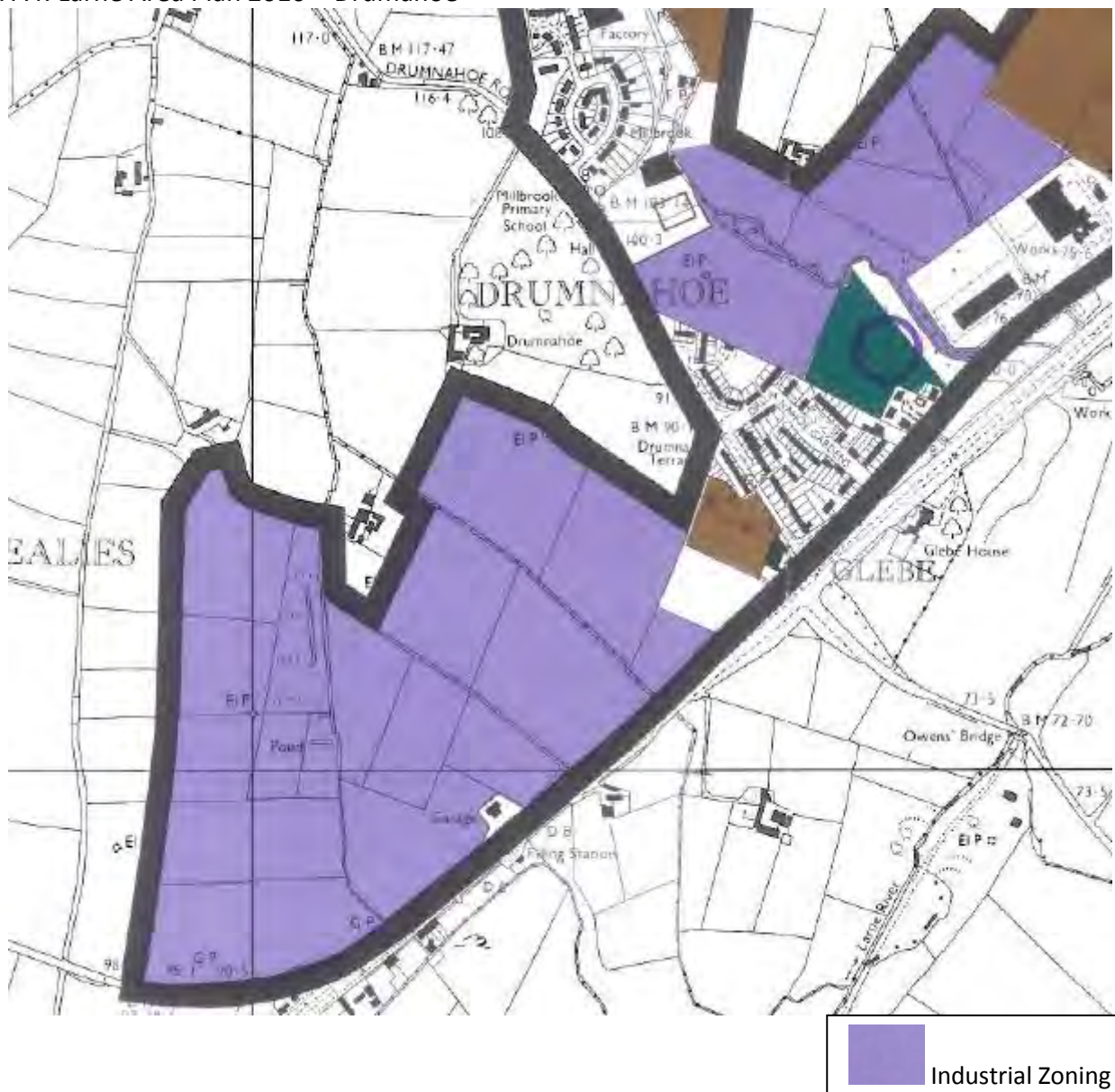




Fig. A5: Larne Area Plan 2010 – Larne Harbour

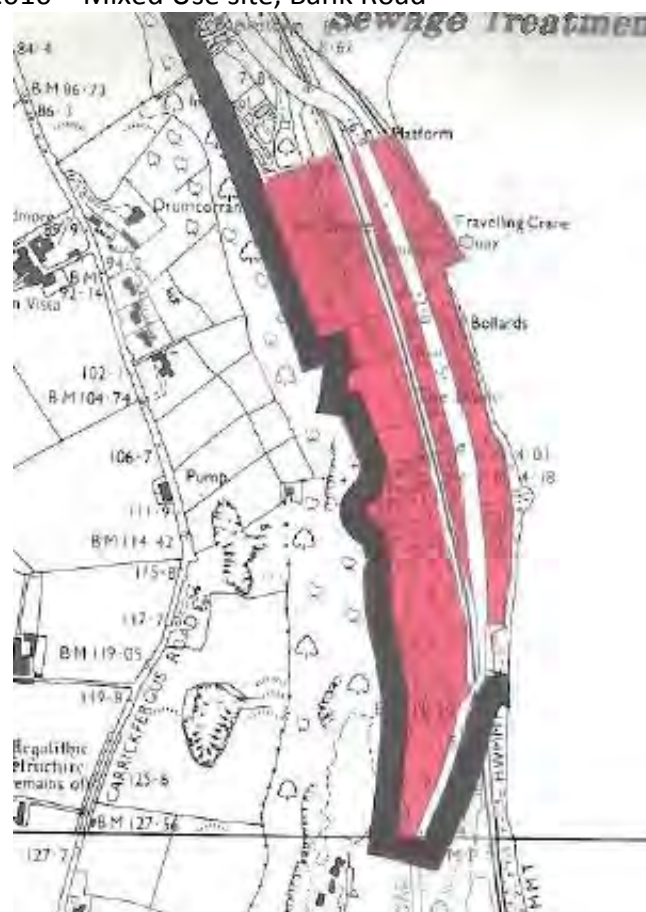


Fig. A7: Carrickfergus Area Plan 2001- Trooperslane Industrial Estate (I1)

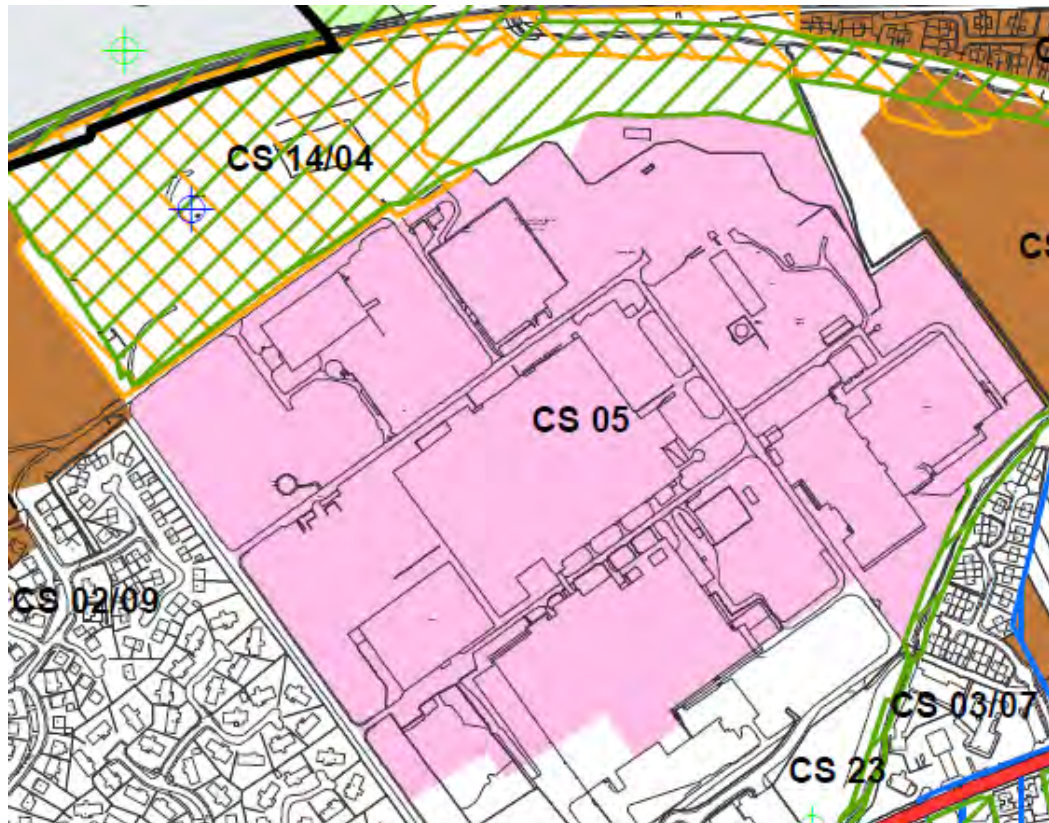


Fig. A10: Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan- Land at Larne Road Kilroot (CS 06)

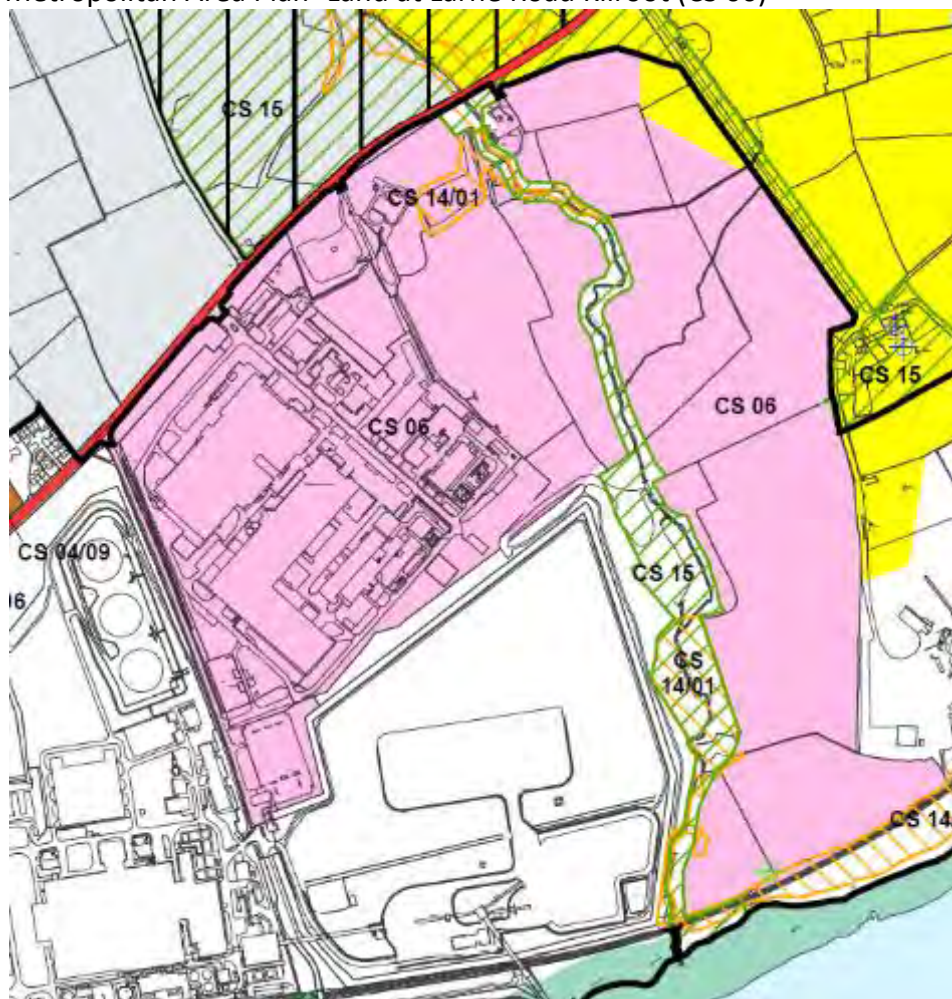




Fig. A11: Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan- Keeburn Industrial Estate, Woodburn Road (CS 07)

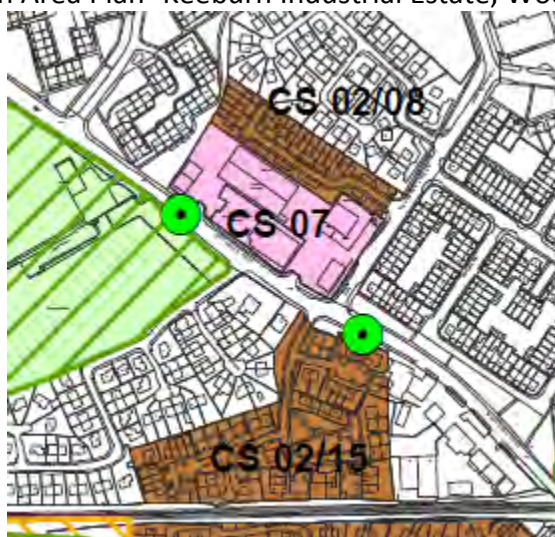


Fig. A12: Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan- Engineering Works, Woodburn Road (CS 08)

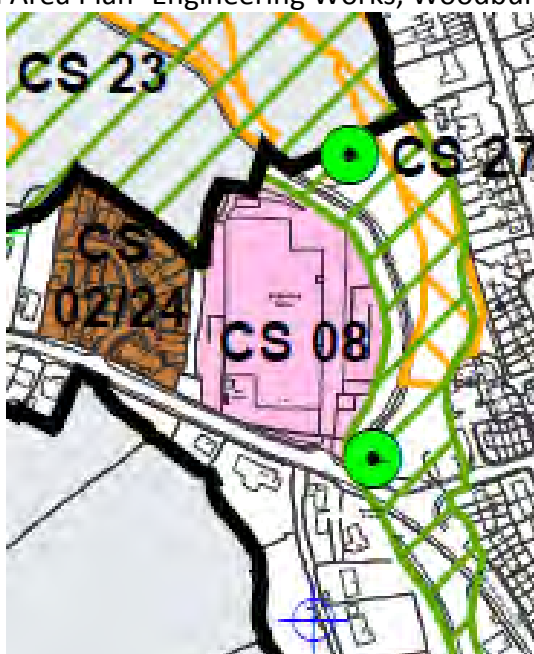


Fig. A13: Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan- Land at Trailcock Road, Carrickfergus (CS 09)

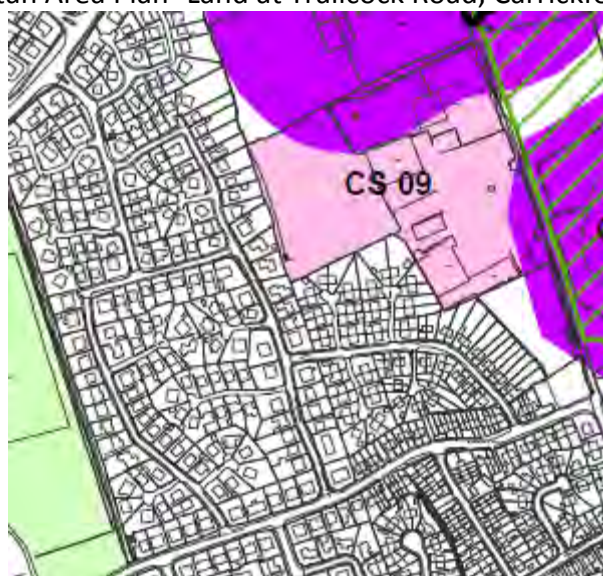


Fig. A14: Belfast Metropolitan Area Plan- Trooperslane (CS 10)

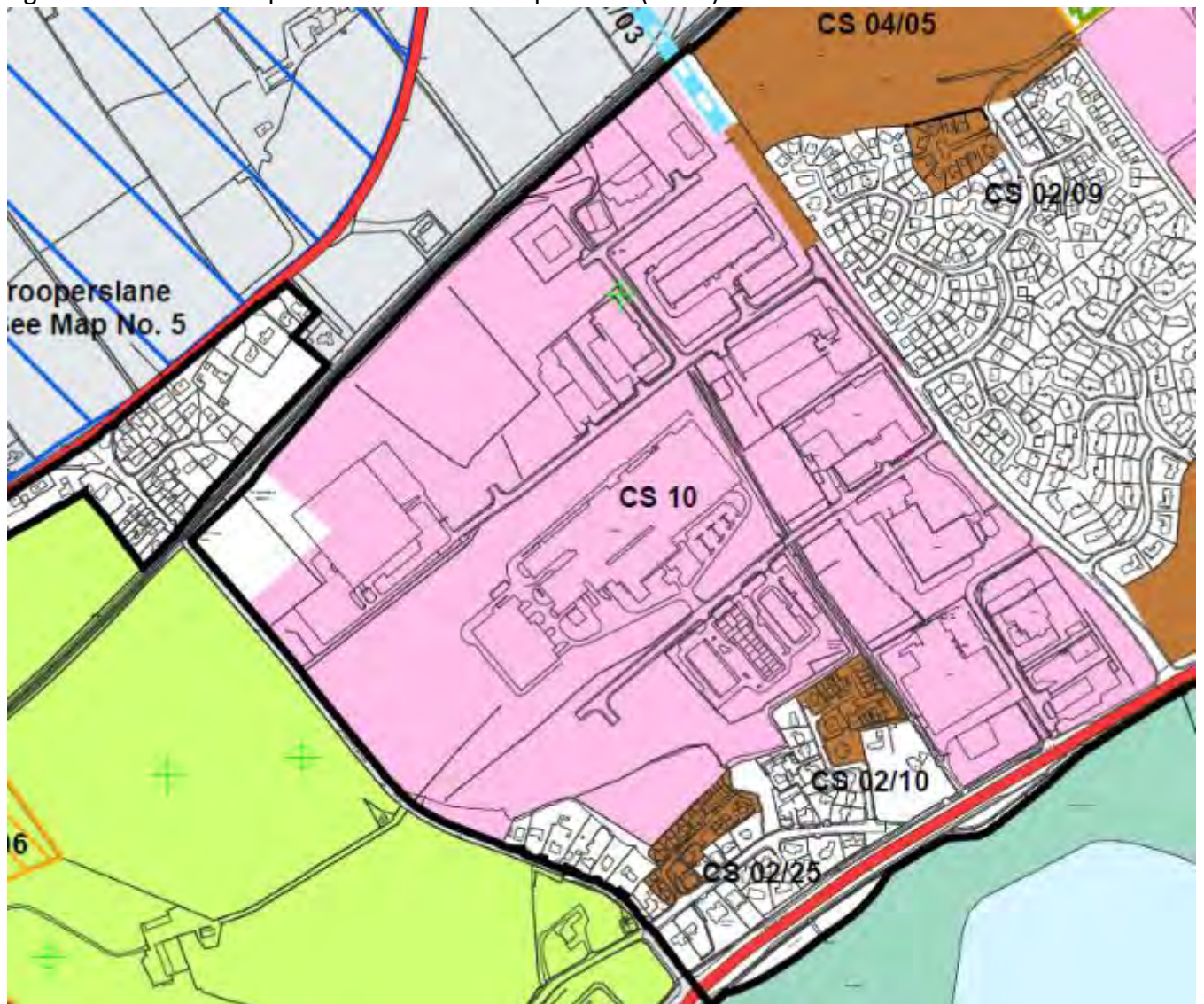

Fig. E1: Qualifications of Population over 16 years in Mid & East Antrim District- 2011

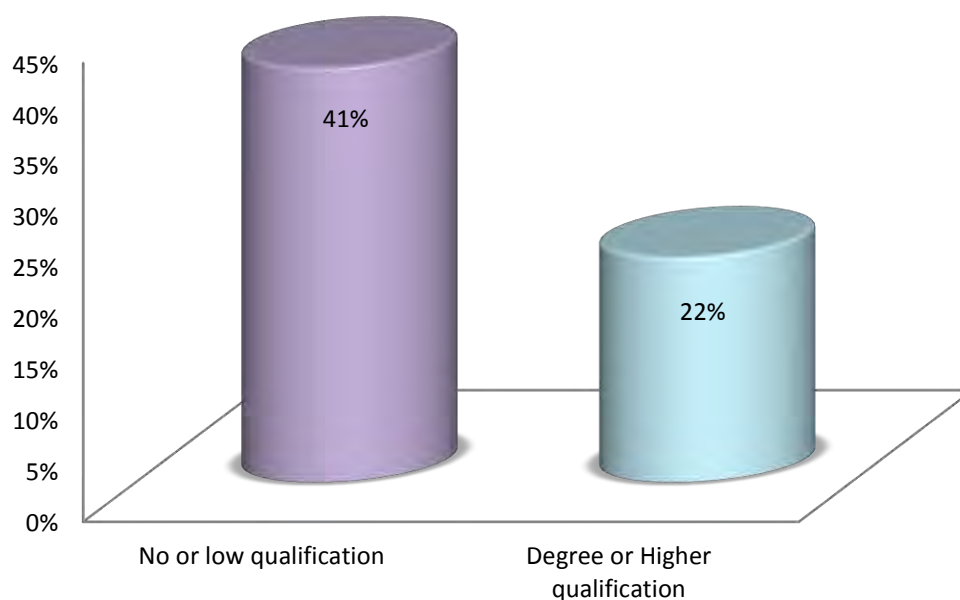













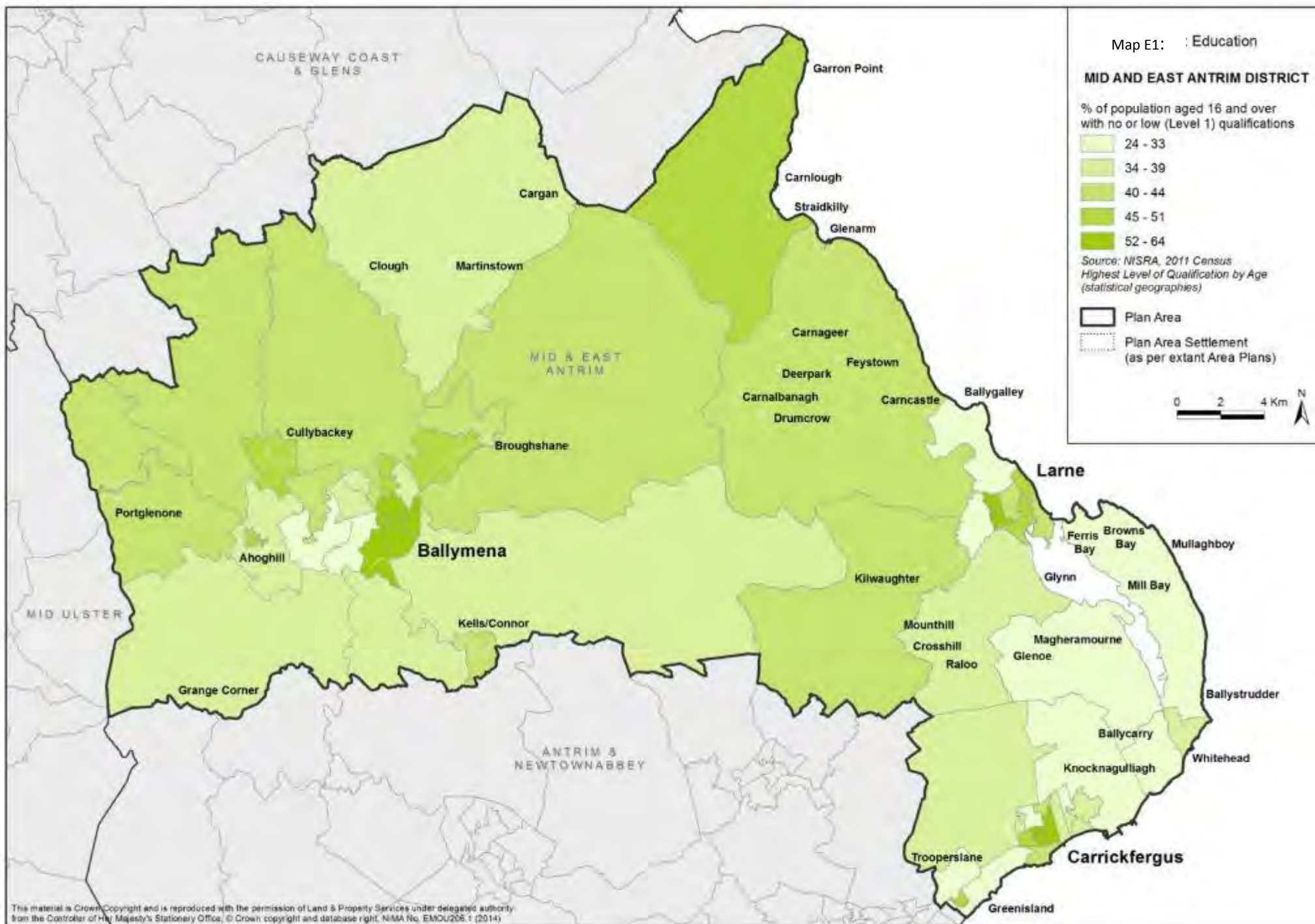

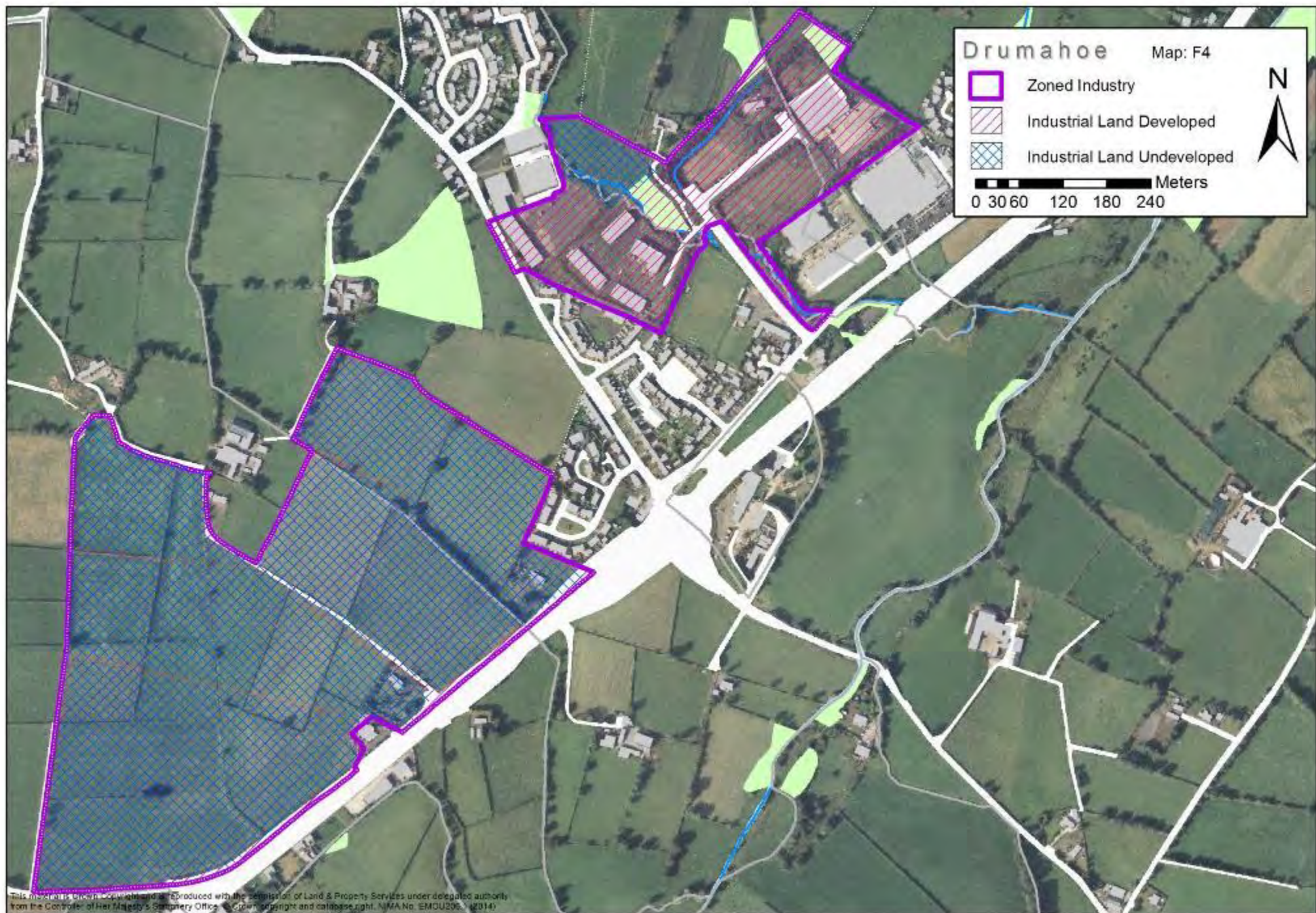












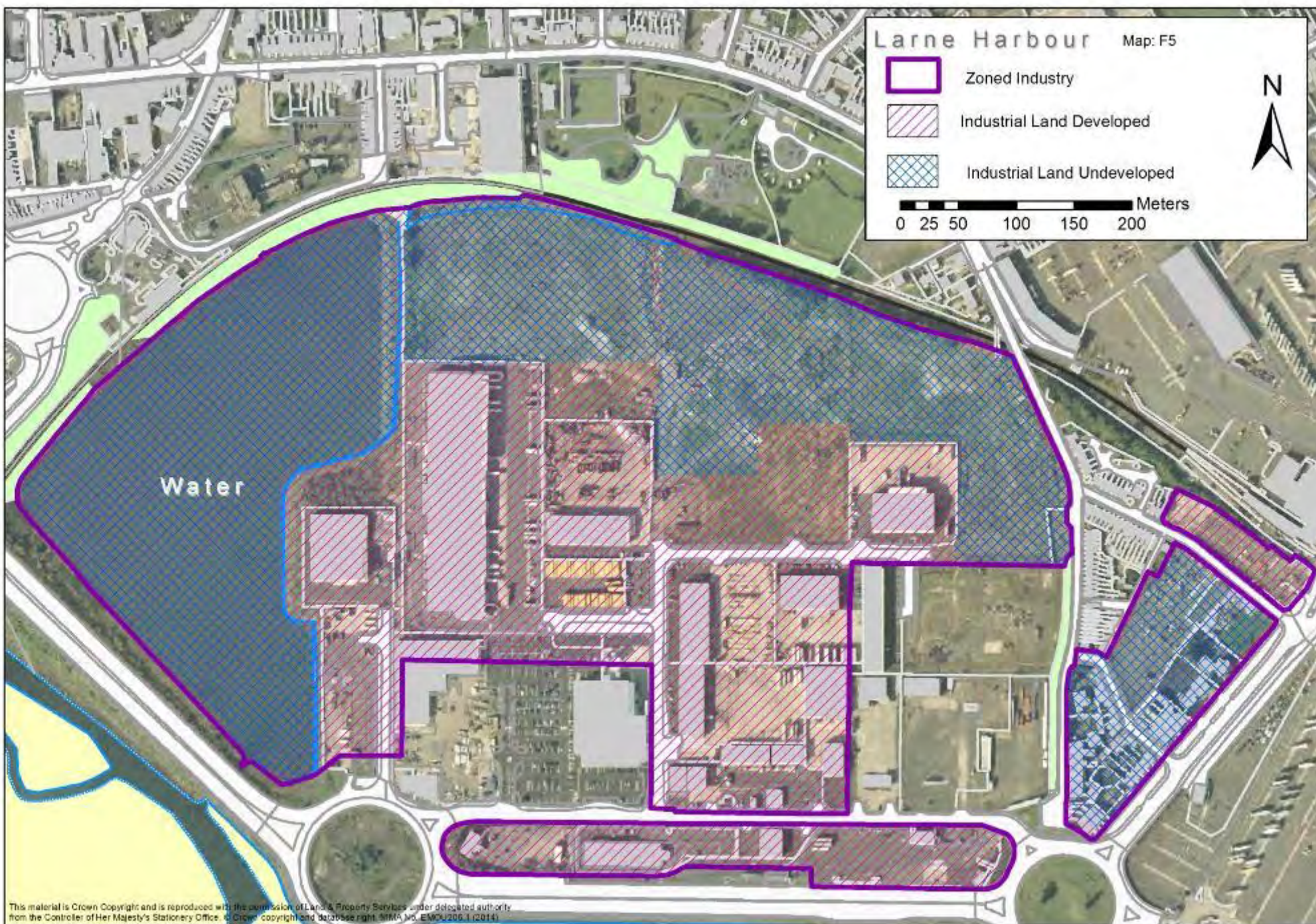
