What goes into your recycling boxes?



Items we can't collect

- ✗ Power tools
- ✗ Plastic bags, films, wrappings or toys
- ✗ Broken glass
- ✗ Towels, duvets or pillows
- ✗ Batteries (car or household)
- ✗ Textiles

Please note

- Make sure all items for recycling are clean and don't contain any food or drink residue
- Flatten cans, cartons, plastics and cardboard to save space
- Make sure lids are closed properly and secured by placing a heavy object on them
- On collection day, make sure boxes are left out for 7.30am
- Collection times may vary in the holiday period

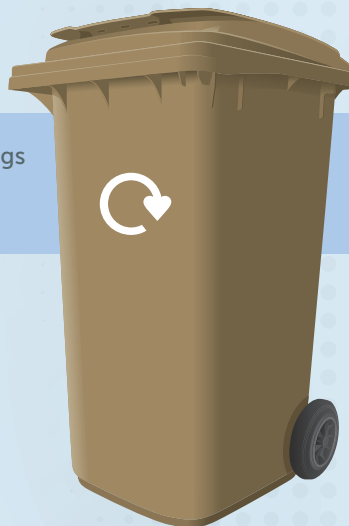

What goes into your brown bin?

You can put food, recyclable household and garden waste in your brown bin.

Each household will get three rolls of food waste bags throughout the year, if you need any more please contact the office using the details on the back.



Accepted

- ✓ Food waste
- ✓ Meat and fish, raw and cooked, including bones
- ✓ Fruit and vegetables – peelings, raw and cooked
- ✓ All dairy products – including cheese and yoghurt
- ✓ Eggshells
- ✓ Breads, cakes and pastries
- ✓ Rice, pasta and beans
- ✓ Uneaten food from your plate
- ✓ Tea bags and coffee grounds
- ✓ Mouldy food
- ✓ Ready meals
- ✓ Household and garden waste
- ✓ Cold ash
- ✓ Kitchen roll
- ✓ Tissue paper
- ✓ Takeaway pizza boxes, please crush
- ✓ Grass cuttings
- ✓ Shredded paper
- ✓ Sawdust
- ✓ Tree and hedge prunings
- ✓ Garden plants and weeds
- ✓ Leaves, twigs and bark
- ✓ Flowers

Not accepted

- ✗ All packaging, with the exception of crushed takeaway pizza boxes
- ✗ Packaging from ready meals
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Soil, rubble and stones
- ✗ Pet waste
- ✗ Cardboard



Good to know

Only use compostable food waste bags or newspaper to line your food caddy, before disposing in your brown bin.
