# The Dogs on Leads (Carnlough, Ballygally and Browns Bay Beaches Mid and East Antrim Borough Council) Order 2015

Mid and East Antrim Borough Council hereby makes the following Order:

### Commencement

1. This Order comes into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016.

# Application

2. This Order applies to the land specified in Schedule 1.

### Offence

- 3. (1) Any person in charge of a dog is guilty of an offence if, during the times and periods specified in Schedule 2, on any land to which this Order applies the person does not keep the dog on a lead of not more than 1.8 metres (6 feet) in length, unless-
  - (a) the person has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
  - (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to the person failing to do so.
  - (2) For the purposes of this Article a person who habitually has a dog in their possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

### Penalty

4. A person guilty of an offence under Article 3 is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
