If this information is available on the website then please also indicate when the requested information (spreadsheet or website) has been updated and a link to this if available.

I therefore request a breakdown including the following information:

- A) The name of each business in respect of which non-domestic rates are payable.
- B) The Rateable value of the property.
- C) The address of the business in respect of which non-domestic rates apply.
- D) The date the account was created.
